Important Note: As class size is limited some prospective students may not be able to register as the class may be full. Therefore do not purchase supplies until your registration in the class has been confirmed. Substituting other materials for the materials listed by the instructor is not recommended.

Cleaning Supplies Needed for ALL Art Courses:

- 2-3 plastic cloths to cover table and floor area. Options - shower curtain, tablecloth, garbage bags, or poly vapor barrier
- soap (liquid detergent or bar of Ivory soap) and scrub brush
- Water container –jar/jug/yogurt/margarine
- Appropriate clothing – smock/apron
- Rags or paper towels for hands and cleaning up

Please disregard the line in the Registration Guide that states “Other supplies will be provided in class subject to a \$40.00 supply fee”.

Undiscounted prices for the required supports and masking tape below total to approximately \$50, based on prices from Delta Art and Drafting Supply. Students will likely find better prices. As Terraskin paper is not always easy to source, Samantha and Rick will have a small supply on hand for students to purchase if they are unable to purchase it in time for the workshop. It was chosen to reduce the cost of supports for the students

Optional items listed below are truly optional.

Required Supports

- Two 28"x40" sheets of terraskin stone paper
- Two 10" x 10" (3/4 thick) cradled wood panels
- Eight 6" x 6" uncradled wood panels (or masonite)

Required Tools

- Masking tape
- Water container
- Favorite mark-making tools (only what students already own)
 - brushes

- paint knives
- rubber paint shapers

Optional Tools

- Palette, palette paper, or wax paper
- Spray bottle
- Toothbrush
- Eye dropper or plastic pipette
- Gloves or barrier cream
- Defunct plastic gift cards or other plastic material
- Plastic core board, gator board, or similar on which to tape down paper for painting.

Other Optional

- Reference photos if students wish
- Toner prints for photo transfers
- Students may bring their own acrylic paints and media but they are NOT required

- Isopropyl alcohol
- Optional tools will be lent out by the instructors where required.
