## **TOOLS and SUPPLIES**

### **Flexcut DETAIL Carving Knife**

- It is not necessary to buy the starter set of knives – ask for the DETAIL carving knife – don’t waste your money on a set – the Flexcut detail knife is available at Lee Valley Tools (Lee Valley Tools Catalogue # 06D05.13), Canadian Woodworker, and sometimes at KMS Tools.

### **Gouges/Chisels – Japanese Detail Carving Set**

- Available at Lee Valley Tools Catalogue # 44D10.05 (Bring any carving tools you already own as well – they may be useful)

### **For Those Who Might Never Carve Again**

- If you are not sure if you will carve again consider the cheaper Japanese Set Catalogue # 58D00.05 This set is considerably cheaper but the cheaper price comes with a price – these tools tend to need more attention to keep them sharp. They are adequate for anyone who wants to see if carving might be an option for them.

**Note:** It is possible to borrow a set of these tools from the Instructor – please contact the instructor [wilsonlarson@gmail.com](mailto:wilsonlarson@gmail.com) to let her know this is your intent as she has only 4 or 5 sets of these to loan.

### **Supply Cost to Purchase from Instructor - Prices Range from \$20 to \$30**

This fee will include:

- **Bark for carving**
- **All adhesives and spreaders**
- **Materials for preparing bark to carve**
- **Sand Paper**
- **Finishes and applicators**
- **Protective coverings for adhesive and finishing stations**

**The use of a rotary tool is optional** but will be available for students to use as they work on their project. This project can be completed with a knife and the detail carving set.

## Rotary Tool

- Freedom, Dremel or similar and any Bits you have to use with this tool. **If you own one of these we will use them – if not 3 will be supplied by the instructor for shared student use**
- We will use a **round ball bit** that has some teeth to it (a bur style bit) - It would also be helpful to have the **sanding drums with sleeves** that usually come with rotary tools.
- If you have a **dust collector for your rotary tool** – one that is portable – contact the instructor to discuss bringing it

**ALL students should bring N95 face masks** (disposable dust masks) for use with the rotary tools. Even when using a dust collector, a face mask is advised.

**Eye protection** – dust glasses/goggles for anyone who doesn't wear glasses, in case bark bits fly off while using the rotary tool.

## Other Supplies

- 2-3 plastic cloths to cover table and floor area. Options – shower curtain, tablecloth, garbage bags, or poly vapor barrier
