Do not purchase supplies until your registration in the class has been confirmed: class sizes are limited, and the class fills up quickly.

Substituting other materials for the materials listed below is not recommended. Unless specified “dollar store” or “office supply”, the instructor recommends student purchase quality products from participating art stores. Please, no other substitute from art stores unless confirmed with the instructor.

Drawing Materials:

- One regular HB pencil
- 2h pencil
- Woodless graphite pencil 2b, 4b, 6b
- Hard vine or willow charcoal
- 1 white charcoal pencil
- 1 stick of white charcoal or white pastel
- 4b and 6b charcoal pencil
- 1 stick of compressed charcoal
- 1 conte pencil # 610 Sanguine
- one conte stick colour sanguine
- \$2.50 for graphite powder if purchasing from instructor

Paper:

- About 20-30 sheets of Xerox/bond paper
- 4 sheets of Stonehenge paper (22x30 inch) (please note: additional paper may be purchased – depending upon student speed of achievement in class)
- 1 sheet of Canson Mi teintes Black
- 1 sheet of Canson Mi Teintes Steel Grey
- 1 sheet of Canson Mi-Teintes Cream

Erasers:

- Staedtler kneaded eraser
 - 1 white eraser
 - 1 tuff stuff (mechanical eraser) and/or battery operated eraser (battery operated takes 2 triple A batteries)
 - 1 maped epure eraser
- *If purchasing graphite please bring exact change to class, as the instructor will not have change.

Other materials:

- Dust brush or paint/cosmetic brush – which ever is more economical-one can go to the dollar store for this item
- 12 inch ruler
- 6 blending stumps of variety sizes (please note 2 will be used for each medium)
- Masking tape
- Cheese cloth
- Dollar store tea strainer (look for a tea strainer that has fine pores similar to the screen on a window)
- One pencil sharpener
- Dollar store spice container to put graphite powder in
- Notepad and pen to write your own notes
- 2-3 plastic cloths to cover table and floor area. Options – shower curtain, tablecloth, garbage bags, or poly vapor barrier
- Appropriate clothing – smock/apron
- Rags or paper towels for hands and for cleaning up

Based on estimated cost for materials from two art stores, students will spend between \$60-80(the quote is based on regular price and no discount). The price may vary due to items on sale and student discount. The above price is not including materials purchased at dollar stores or from the instructor.
