Substituting other materials for the materials listed below is not recommended. Unless specified “dollar store” or “office supply”, the instructor recommends student purchase quality products from participating art stores.

Surfaces

- One yard of pre-primed un-stretched canvas. This canvas will be cut down into smaller pieces approximately 12X16 inches.
- Do not fold this canvas. Store it rolled up.

Brushes

Note: It is very important that each brush be a synthetic brush. The length of the hairs should be about an inch. The brushes are not especially large. The width of the hairs should be about half an inch.

- W&N ARTIST ACRYLIC BRUSH LH - Filbert 239 Size 2
- W&N ARTIST ACRYLIC BRUSH LH - Filbert 239 Size 10
- W&N ARTIST ACRYLIC BRUSH LH - Flat 236 Size 8
- W&N ARTIST ACRYLIC BRUSH LH - Flat 236 Size 10
- W&N ARTIST ACRYLIC BRUSH LH - Flat 236 Size 12

Paints

One tube of each of the following colours in either Galleria or Liquitex Basics brands (prefer large tubes):

- Titanium White
- Ultramarine Blue
- Prussian Blue or Primary Blue (meaning a greenish blue)
- Quinacridone Magenta
- Primary Yellow
- Cadmium Yellow Pale

- One large palette knife - exclusively for mixing colours
- One Palette
- One package of disposable palettes or Butcher's Tray. (Size should be approximately 11 x 14 inches. Students have also used Styrofoam plates as palettes with success)

The rest of these items can be purchased anywhere.

- A single board to attach the canvas to (12X16 inches or slightly larger)
- One watercolour pencil – any colour.
- One roll of masking tape.
- Paper towels
- Apron to help prevent getting paint on your clothes.
- One small squirt bottle (to mist the paints to stop them from drying too quickly.)
- A hairdryer to dry the acrylic paint even faster.
- Two large one litre water containers
- 2 – 3 plastic cloths to cover table and floor area. Options: plastic tablecloth, shower curtains or poly barrier

Other optional items will be discussed in the first class.
